

Our Vision




TAG's vision is to provide an environment that prepares students to apply their knowledge in order to question, evaluate, and solve ever rising global challenges.




2023 NY State ELA Data

2022-2023 NYS Math Results



Admission to Specialized High Schools

Our 8th Grade students take Regents exams in all core subject areas (English, Algebra I, Living Environment, US History, as well as Second Language Proficiency/Checkpoint A- Spanish). Many gain admission to Specialized High Schools, including

- Stuyvesant High School
- The Bronx High School of Science
- Brooklyn Technical High School
- LaGuardia High School of Music and Art and Performing Arts
- High School for Math Science and Engineering at City College
- High School for American Studies at Lehman College







TAG shares its building with two other schools: Esperanza Preparatory Academy (grades 6-12) and PS138 (a District 75 school). The schools function independently of one another, each with its own classrooms and hallways used only by its respective students and staff. School principals coordinate lunch times, assemblies, drop-off and dismissal, to ensure the safety of all students.

School Uniforms

- TAG is a uniform school, and students are expected to wear uniforms each day.
- Students are allowed to dress down on their birthday, for certain school trips, and other special occasions designated by the school.
- Students wear a gym uniform one day each week, on their designated gym day.

In addition to studying core subjects with teachers in their main classrooms, students attend "cluster classes" in Art, Music, Chorus, Physical Education, and Spanish, Inquiry & Explorations.

TAG DAILY SCHEDULE



- School hours are 8:05am-2:25pm.
- The school doors open at 7:35am, and free breakfast is available for all students. As middle school students arrive, they report to the gymnasium and are supervised until 8:05am. Middle school students are then escorted to their lockers.
- A typical school day has eight periods, including lunch/recess.

BUSING (up to 6th Grade)

DOE-provided "Yellow Bus," service available to certain Manhattan residents only





- Students qualify based on Department of Pupil Transportation guidelines
- Eligibility depends on the grade of the student, distance from the school, etc.
- Families must request bus service at the school

Many private busing companies exist, but they will establish a route only if enough students sign up to make the run profitable. Several TAG families, in cooperation with the PTA, have united to establish private bus routes in northwestern Manhattan, and in parts of the Bronx and Queens.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION TO TAG:



- Students not served by yellow buses qualify for student Metrocards, good for three free subway or public bus rides each school day.
- Closest MTA subway stop: The 6 train to 110th St. Station
- Closest MTA buses: M15 downtown (on 2nd Ave.) M101/M102/M103 uptown (on 3rd Ave.)

YMCA AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM:

- The school's on-site after-school program is operated by the Vanderbilt YMCA, and so long as funding is allocated, remains free of charge.
- YMCA staff work in TAG classrooms, with students divided by grades, supervising homework and offering enrichment activities such as SHSAT prep, art, crafts, drama, and recreation.

Health Services:



TAG benefits from an on-site health center run by Mount Sinai Medical Center. The clinic is open on school days from 8:30am-3:00pm. The following services are available: <u>Students must be registered with the clinic to be eligible for services</u> <u>First aid is available to all students</u>
